_____ Quality portfolio of artwork (on a USB flash drive) to include the following:

- A. 6-10 pieces of work.
- B. Any fine arts medium is acceptable, but greater emphasis should be placed on drawing from life, design projects, and three-dimensional works.

Student Portfolio Guidelines

1. Photograph 6-10 samples of your best artwork. Include a range of original works – drawing, design, painting, ceramics, printmaking, etc. as well as your sketchbook.
 - Please do not include work that is copied from photographs, anime drawings, cartoons, video game characters, or another artist's work.
2. Create a cover page, Number each image, and combine all images into a single PDF file with the cover page first. Label your file as **lastname_firstname_images**.
3. Include a numbered **Image List** that corresponds with each numbered image. Make sure your list includes: titles of work, media, and dates of completion. For example:
#1 *Garden Oasis*, embroidery on hand-dyed fabric, 2022
#2 *Propping Up Clouds*, graphite on paper, 2022

Documentation of Art - Helpful Tips:

- Make sure you are photographing the art, not background clutter.
- Photograph work on a plain, neutral background.
- Crop your image so that your art fill as much of the frame as possible.
- If you do not have access to a lighting setup, photograph your work outside on an overcast day or inside next to a window for natural light. This will provide even light and prevent harsh shadows.
